OREGON LAUNCHES WHAT'S LEGAL? What Oregonians Need to Know About the New Recreational Marijuana Laws

What: The State of Oregon—via the Oregon Liquor Control Commission—is launching a public education campaign about Oregon's the new recreational marijuana laws. Starting July 1, adults 21 and older can legally possess and use recreational marijuana.

The campaign, *What's Legal*?, clarifies what is allowed—and what is not—under the new laws. It will launch June 16 with a media campaign and a dedicated website that includes a suite of materials designed to educate people about the laws and help them share the information with others.

There will be media briefing and Q&A to coincide with the launch including:

- A brief overview of key provisions of the law (the aspects Oregonians have been most curious about);
- An inside look at the campaign strategy and creative; and
